Subject: Discussion and Possible Action on a Request for Maintenance to the Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility

Summary

The Wastewater Treatment Plant requires interior and exterior brick and tuck point repairs on the holding tank walls. The cost of this repair work is \$18,425. Current treatment plant funds are available to pay for this work.

Eric Bollerud has previously completed work at the treatment plant in the past. Therefore, staff feels comfortable accepting his estimate to complete the necessary work.

Because the overall project cost is greater than \$10,000, Council approval is required for the expenditure.

Recommendation

City Staff recommends approval of the tuck pointing repairs at the wastewater treatment facility in the amount of \$18,425 with Eric Bollerud.
