



Super Special Ladies Day Out

In Milton, Wisconsin

Enjoy a light breakfast at [Charming B's Coffee & More](#), 819 E. High Street, located in Chapel Specialties, a former Methodist Church constructed in 1883. Make sure to leave time to shop. [Artworks](#), a local art gallery, has items displayed for sale. Plan ahead and make an appointment at [The Catwalk Salon](#), [Facials by Laura](#), or [Affinity Massage & Bodywork](#), which are all located at Chapel Specialties.



Spend the morning shopping around Goodrich Square, Milton's eastside downtown district. There is consignment shopping at [Corner Closet](#), 251 Parkview Drive, and [Kim's Kloset](#), 237 Parkview Drive. [Goodrich Hall Antiques](#), 501 College Street, is located in a former women's dormitory constructed in 1857 for the Milton College, which closed in 1982. [Goodrich Antiques & Uniques](#), 742 E. Madison Avenue, is another great place in Milton to find antiques and is owned by the same family as Goodrich Hall Antiques. It is located in the former Ezra Goodrich House. Ezra was the son of Joseph Goodrich, the founder of Milton. [Loose Threads](#), 8005 N. US Hwy 26, is located just on the fringe of the City of Milton limits and is a full-service quilt and yarn shop.



Enjoy lunch at [Northleaf Bistro & Market](#), 220 S. Janesville Street, where you can enjoy a soup, sandwich, and a glass of wine from Northleaf Winery located right next door. Don't worry; you will stop back at the winery in the afternoon.



After lunch, make the short drive over to Merchant Row, Milton's westside downtown district, and enjoy shopping at even more unique shops. Cranberry Cottage, 144 Merchant Row, is an antique and gift shop. The [Old Junction Mill](#), 613 W. Madison Avenue, used to be a tobacco warehouse and later a feed mill. Currently, it houses three businesses: [Red Rooster Home Furnishings & Gifts](#), [Lillian's](#) (clothing & accessories), and the [Peddler's Loft](#) featuring over 45 vendors.



Once you are done shopping, head back over to Milton's eastside for a Wine & Chocolate pairing at [Northleaf Winery](#), 232 S. Janesville Street, and arrange for a tour of the winery. The winery is located in the 1850 former John Alexander Wheat Warehouse and is on the National Register of Historic Places.

End your Super Special Ladies Day Out at the [Buckhorn Supper Club](#), 11802 N. Charley Bluff Road, located just outside of Milton on Lake Koshkonong, one of the largest lakes in Wisconsin. Enjoy the beautiful views of the lake and delicious fine dining cuisine.
