Agenda Item #2 Discussion and possible action on roadway adjustment at N. Janesville Street and Madison Avenue intersection

Submitting Staff Member: Howard Robinson, Director of Public Works

Recommended Action: To authorize the installation of new curb at the intersection of N. Janesville Street and Madison Avenue to increase the visibility of the newly installed stop sign.

Description: The new stop sign at the intersection of N. Janesville Street and Madison Avenue was installed approximately two weeks ago. There have been complaints about the visibility of the stop sign since it was installed. A solution to this situation is to move the curb out approximately two or three feet and reduce the angle of the turn, which would make the sign more visible. This would be a long term repair.

Our current concrete contractor can add this project onto his current work at his existing cost. Estimated cost would be:

115 feet of new curb @ \$19.00 per foot	\$2,185.00
New sidewalk and accessible ramp	\$600.00
Concrete sawing	\$500.00

This money would come out of the street repair budget and can be completed this fall if approved.
