Call To Order

Chairperson Ryan Peterson called the April 25, 2022 meeting of the Parks & Recreation Commission to order at 6 p.m.

Present: Chairperson Ryan Peterson, Ald. Eric Stockman, Karen Reed, Lee Ann Hare, Luke Murphy, David Snow, and Annette Smith.

Also Present: Public Works Director Mark Langer, Operations Crew Lead Paul Smith, and Administrative Services Director Inga Cushman.

Approve Agenda

Comm. Hare motioned to approve the agenda. Comm. Smith seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Introduction Of New Members - Ald. Eric Stockman And Lucas Murphy

All commissioners in attendance introduced themselves to the new members.

Election Of Chairperson

Comm. Reed nominated Chairperson Peterson to continue as chairperson for the commission. Comm. Ald. Stockman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Approval Of Minutes - November 15, 2021

Comm. Smith motioned to approve the minutes. Comm. Reed seconded, and the motion carried.

Update On Improvements At North Goodrich Park

P. Smith provided an update on the installation of the playground at North Goodrich Park. The target is to have the playground installed by the end of May, but it may be sooner depending on the weather.

Discussion And Possible Action On Arbor Day Celebration

Director Cushman stated the City received a grant from Alliant Energy's Community Tree program and One Million Trees Initiative. This will allow the commission to plant approximately 20 trees at each King Park and Crossridge Park. Director Cushman suggested the dates for planting be May 7, 2022 at 10 a.m. and May 14, 2022 at 10 a.m. The commission agreed with those dates, and Director Cushman stated she would start promoting the events.

Discussion And Possible Action On Tails N Trails Dog Park Clean Up - April 30, 2022

Director Cushman stated the Tails n Trails Dog Park Clean Up will take place on April 30, 2022 at 10 a.m.

Discussion And Possible Action On Baseball Field Advertising Sign Program

The commission discussed the Baseball Field Advertising Sign Program. Central Park was included in the program, but it's now owned and operated by the School District of Milton. The commission decided to see how Liberty Park is used this season, and then discuss this program more in the fall.

Discussion And Possible Action On Development Of Signs For Disc Golf Course And Gaga Ball Pit

Director Cushman received a quote from a local graphic designer to design signs for the disc golf course and the gaga ball pit.

Comm. Reed motioned to table this item until a future meeting so additional options can be obtained. Comm. Ald. Stockman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion And Possible Action On Horse Hitching Posts At FFA Park And Merchant Row

The commission discussed the hitching posts located at FFA Park and on Merchant Row.

Comm. Hare motioned to remove the hitching post at FFA Park and continue to maintain the hitching post on Merchant Row. Comm. Snow seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion And Possible Action On Trail Clean Up Day At Mud Lake

Director Cushman stated this is part of the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. The commission decided to select a fall date for this clean up at a future meeting.

Discussion And Possible Action On Make A Difference Day

Director Cushman stated this is part of the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan. She said the Community Development Authority discussed a similar event at their last meeting, and are planning to discuss it more at their meeting on May 16, 2022. Director Cushman will report back to the commission about a possible partnership between the two groups.

There were no general items.


Set Next Meeting Date
