Summary

Redgie A Staskal Reliable Guardianship Services Inc., has submitted a 3-Lot Certified Survey Map along Capman Street. The CSM effectively transfers a small portion of land to 731 Capman Street (Lot 1) and 435 Elm Street (Lot 3) from an existing vacant parcel along Capman Street (Lot 2).

Analysis and Key Issues

After the reduction in land from the vacant parcel (Lot 2) this lot is still meets zoning ordinance standards for size and frontage. Additionally, this land division bring Lot 1 into conformity with the existing structure being built across a lot line.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City of Milton for this land division.
