Summary

Baxter & Woodman has provided the attached Work Order Amendment No. 1 for additional engineering services along Madison Avenue and N. Clear Lake Avenue.

Analysis and Key Issues

Staff was directed by the Common Council at the July 5th meeting to prepare detailed documentation information for utility improvements and both concrete and asphalt for pricing for Madison Avenue and N. Clear Lake Avenue. The work order amendment provides for this work. The original work order included engineering services for replacement of water main and pavement repair along Madison Avenue. The additional work includes pavement rehabilitation and utility work along Madison Avenue and N. Clear Lake Avenue.

Fiscal Impact

Baxter & Woodman has provided an amendment to the original work order for services not to exceed \$41,181.25. The total increase for the additional work is \$27,281.25. The actual amount billed will be based on actual work time performed.

Approve the Work Order Amendment No. 1 from Baxter & Woodman for the Madison Avenue Water Main Replacement.
