Call to Order and Confirmation of Appropriate Meeting Notice

Laehn motioned to approve the agenda combining the following agenda items: Discussion and Possible Action on A Petition to Join the Edgerton Fire Protection District by the Town of Harmony, Town of Johnstown, Town of Lima, Town of Milton, and City of Milton; and Discussion and Possible Action on an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Town of Harmony, Town of Johnstown, Town of Lima, Town of Milton, and City of Milton. Jenny Lukas, Milton-Milton Township Fire Department, requested clarification on the following language included in the agreement: The Board may subcontract for emergency medical services, or at its discretion, develop and maintain said services for the purpose of providing said services within the District.

Ald. Clark motioned to approve the Fire Protection and Services Intergovernmental Agreement as presented contingent upon the approval of all ten municipalities. Ald. Holbrook seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.
