Summary

On July 26, 2022, the City of Milton along with the Towns of Milton, Harmony, Johnstown and Lima all signed the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) to effectuate the joining of the Edgerton Fire Protection District. Since that time, some minor adjustments have been made to the agreement that was previously approved. Therefore, the Common Council (along with the other municipalities who had approved the previous version) will need to review those changes and approve the document again.

Analysis and Key Issues

The changes to the previously approved document revolve directly around some aspects of the previously approved MOU and Petition which outlines roles and responsibilities of the existing municipalities and the newly joining municipalities. The language added to the IGA is already reflected in the previously approved and binding MOU and Petition, but some felt it was important to memorialize some of those aspects into the IGA as it will be the standing governing doctrine of the district once approved by all 10 municipalities.

Therefore, the City Administration and City Legal Counsel have no objections or concerns with the addition of this language to the IGA document.

Fiscal Impact

There is no additional fiscal impact to the City of Milton precipitated by these changes.

Recommended Motion

Approval of the revised Intergovernmental Agreement with the Edgerton Fire Protection District as presented.
