### Summary

Replacement of outdoor ductwork insulation located at the WWTP lab building and the biosolids thickening building.

### Analysis and Key Issues

The insulation and cladding located on the outdoor ductwork at the WWTP lab building and the biosolids thickening building is failing and in need of replacement. Wastewater operators obtained quotes from Express Insulation to complete the work.

### Fiscal Impact

The total amount to install the outdoor ductwork insulation at two locations at the WWTP is \$9,440 and will be funded by the Wastewater Utility.

### Recommended Motion

City administration recommends approving the quotes from Express Insulation for the replacement of the outdoor ductwork insulation.
