Call To Order

Chairperson Ryan Peterson called the August 15, 2022 meeting of the Parks & Recreation Commission to order at 6:01 p.m.

Present: Chairperson Ryan Peterson, Ald. Eric Stockman, Karen Reed, Lee Ann Hare, Annette Smith, and Logan Purdy.

Approve Agenda

Comm. Reed motioned to approve the agenda. Comm. Purdy seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Approval Of Minutes - July 18, 2022

Comm. Ald. Stockman motioned to approve the minutes. Comm. Smith seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion And Possible Action On Signs For Disc Golf Course

The commission discussed the design for the signs.

Comm. Hare motioned to use the horizontal design with the logo removed and the designer's name and the year added. Comm. Ald. Stockman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Director Cushman is working on obtaining a price quote and will have that on the next agenda.

Discussion And Possible Action On Purchase Of Four Benches For The Splash Pad

Comm. Smith motioned to purchase four new metal black benches for the splash pad to replace the wooden benches in an amount not to exceed \$5,000. Comm. Ald. Stockman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion And Possible Action On Placement Of Bike Racks For Veterans Park, North Goodrich Park, Tower Hill Park, Watertower Park, And King Park

The commission discussed locations for the bike racks. At Tower Hill Park they prefer it by the bench. For King Park, they prefer it near the concrete pad in the wooded area with the picnic tables. The preferred location for Veterans Park is to the east of the pavilion near the men's restroom. For North Goodrich Park, the preferred location is near the Community House on the west side of the building.

Discussion And Possible Action On Clean Up Day At Mud Lake

The commission discussed a clean up day at Mud Lake, and they will discuss this more at a future meeting.

Update On Born Learning Trail At Crossridge Park

Director Cushman stated the Born Learning Trail will be installed by volunteers on United Way Blackhawk Region's Annual Day of Caring on September 14 by volunteers from Diamond Assets, the sponsor of the trail.

General Items

The commission discussed ordering t-shirts for the commissioners to wear at events.

Comm. Smith asked about adding accessible viewing areas at the ball diamonds at Lamar Park.


Set Next Meeting Date
