Summary

The proposed annexation along North Vickerman Road annexes one half of the right of way of North Vickerman Road that directly adjoins the site. As part of the proposed development, Vickerman Road will need to be improved to an urban industrial standard. Therefore, the attached Highway Order between the City of Milton and the Town of Lima has been prepared to grant the City of Milton authority over both lanes of North Vickerman Road adjacent to the Site.

Analysis and Key Issues

By State Statutes, in order to effectuate the Highway Order, both municipal boards must jointly to approve such an order. Therefore, once the annexation petition is approved by the City of Milton, the City will need to schedule a joint meeting between the Common Council and Town of Lima Town Board.

Fiscal Impact

If the Highway Order is approved, the City of Milton would be responsible for all future maintenance on the subject section of North Vickerman Road. Any improvements made to the subject section of North Vickerman Road related to the proposed development would be the developers responsibility.

Recommended Motion

Authorize the City Administrator to schedule a joint meeting between the Milton Common Council and the Town of Lima Town Board.
