Summary

Clasen Quality Chocolates has submitted a Site Plan to construct a sugar silo facility west of the recently approved rail shed.

Analysis and Key Issues

The proposed facility will be utilized as part of their production facility for storage of raw materials. Although still technically located within their first phase of development, this specific accessory structure was not included in their original submittal or approval. Therefore, Plan Commission review and approval is required.

Because this facility will be an accessory structure to their existing +400,000sf approved facility, the site plan conforms with all ordinance requirements in terms of stormwater, parking, etc. as part of the initial phase approval. Additionally, the site has a Conditional Use Permit for buildings in excess of 50-feet. Therefore, no additional approvals would be required beyond their initial approvals for this accessory structure.

The proposed development does not include landscaping, as this development represents a small portion of the overall 169 acre development site. CQC will be bringing forth a master landscaping plan for the entirety of their site and some point in the near future that will satisfy landscaping requirements for all phases of development.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City of Milton for this proposed facility.

Recommended Motion

The City Administration recommends approval of the site plan as approved.
