

Description of strategic plan connection:

The 4<sup>th</sup> of July festival is a community festival but also an event that brings families together. Multi-generational family gatherings, family engaging events at the festival, and celebration of the youth during the parade are just a few items that align with the strategic plan of facilitating ways to engage parents with their kids.
