**Call To Order**

Chairperson Ryan Peterson called the September 19, 2022 meeting of the Parks & Recreation Commission to order at 6 p.m.

Present: Chairperson Ryan Peterson, Ald. Eric Stockman, Karen Reed, Annette Smith, Luke Murphy, and Lee Ann Hare.

Also Present: Public Works Director Mark Langer and Administrative Services Director Inga Cushman.

**Approve Agenda**

Comm. Ald. Stockman motioned to approve the agenda. Comm. Hare seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

**Approval Of Minutes - August 15, 2022**

Comm. Reed motioned to approve the minutes. Comm. Smith seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

**Election Of Vice Chairperson**

Comm. Reed suggested the commission elect a Vice Chairperson in the event the chairperson is unable to attend.

Comm. Smith nominated Comm. Reed to serve as the Vice Chairperson. Comm. Ald. Stockman seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

**Discussion And Possible Action On The Rules At The Tails N Trails Dog Park.**

This item was placed on the Parks & Recreation Commission for discussion by the Common Council. The commission reviewed the current rules at the dog park and the rules posted at the Jefferson Dog Park. The commission directed staff to contact other municipalities for their rules and procedures. They also discussed pursuing a permitting process. The commission will discuss this more at the next meeting.

**Discussion And Possible Action On Matching Grant Opportunity From GameTime For Playground Equipment**

Comm. Hare motioned to recommend to Council to authorize the purchase of the Alexis play structure, swing set, and merry-go-round from GameTime at a cost of \$71,306.52 using the Park Fund and the balance will come from future fundraising. Comm. Reed seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Comm. Ald. Stockman motioned to select a color scheme that is red, black, and white. Comm. Smith seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

**Discussion And Possible Action On Prairie Seed Collection Events - October 15 And 22**

Director Cushman reminded the commission about the upcoming Prairie Seed Collection events. She will send the information to the school district to include in their communications.

**Discussion And Possible Action On Purchase Of Disc Golf Signs**

There was no new information on this item.

The commission briefly discussed the possibility of having an end-of-season dog splash pad day next year. Staff will plan to have this on an agenda in 2023 for planning purposes.


**Set Next Meeting Date**
