Analysis and Key Issues

Howard Robinson retired in 2021 after serving the City of Milton and its residents for 31 years. City Administration recommended renaming the Public Works Facility in his name.

Fiscal Impact

The attached sign is quoted at \$1,856.69.

Recommended Motion

The City of Milton Administration recommends approving the purchase of the attached sign with a revision to the language to indicate “Howard Robinson Public Works Facility” rather than “Municipal Building”.
