Summary

At the October 4th Public Works Committee Meeting Staff received direction to remove and permanently close the waste oil tank located at 620 W. Madison Avenue.

Analysis and Key Issues

Staff reached out to contractors to obtain proposals to remove the waste oil tank as well as the diesel and gasoline fuel tanks located at 620 W. Madison Avenue. Three contractors provided estimates or proposals and they are attached.

Contractor	Amount
Schaper Excavating & Petroleum LLC	\$6,766.00
Interstate Pump & Tank LLC	\$14,935.00
Ultragreen LLC	15,000.00

All three contractors are listed on the DATCP websites list of tank specialty firms. Staff requested Schaper Excavating and Petroleum LLC provide their certifications to perform this work which are also attached.

Fiscal Impact

The cost for the work will be paid for by the general fund and a matching grant from CIVMIC.

Recommended Motion

Staff recommends approving Schaper Excavating & Petroleum LLC to complete the permanent closure and abandonment of the three tanks located at 620 W. Madison Avenue.
