### Summary

At the March 21, 2023 meeting, Council directed staff to take the necessary steps to amend the parking configuration on College Street to include the following alterations:

- Eliminate the existing 10-minute stall in the first parking stall west of Parkview Drive on the south side of College Street
- Install a “Business Parking Only” sign in the eliminated 10-minute parking stall.

To approve these alterations, Council will need to adopt Ordinance #510 repealing the designation of the first parking stall and approve Resolution 2023-07 designating the stall as business parking only.

### Fiscal Impact

City Staff will incur staff charges for the removal of the existing sign and expense for installing the new “Business Parking Only” sign.

### Recommended Motion

City Administration recommends adoption of Ordinance #510 repealing Section 70-154 (A)(4) of the ordinances regulating parking and approval of Resolution #2023-07 Designating Special Parking Restrictions on College Street
