Subject: Discussion and Possible Action on 2019 Sidewalk Installations.

Discussion

Included in the packet are possible locations for sidewalk installation. Each year, \$25,000 is designated for sidewalk installation and repair. There is enough budgeted to install the sidewalk either on Blanche Drive to the Parkview Drive on the south side of Blanche Drive, or Rogers Street from where the sidewalk starts at Tower Hill Drive to the new subdivision on Gailen Drive. Either of these would leave some sidewalk funds for repairs of existing sidewalks. The other sidewalks shown could be installed with funds from the 2019 budget or with other funds if they become available.

The Rogers Street / Tower Hill sidewalk would close a gape area from Rogers Street to the new Red Hawk Farms Subdivision. The new subdivision will install sidewalks from the existing sidewalk on Rainbow Drive as development occurs.

The Blanche Drive sidewalk would close a gap from Brown Drive to Parkview Drive. Blanche Drive has apartments adjacent to the proposed sidewalks.

We only have enough funding for one of these options. Staff would bid out whichever option is preferred by the Public Works Committee and Common Council
