Summary

In 2020, the City of Milton finalized the new Veteran's Park Pavilion and adjoining off-street parking lot. With school now back in session, it appears as though high school students have begun to park in this public parking lot, thus inhibiting anyone who would wish to park in that lot and enjoy the park and pavilion. Therefore, the City of Milton has received a request to prohibit parking in that lot during school hours to 2-hours or less.

Analysis and Key Issues

Ordinance 483 creates section 70-154(e) of the Cord of General Ordinances of the City of Milton regulating parking at Veterans Park. The Ordinance would allow the City to post signage that would restrict parking within that lot, during school hours to 2-hours. This would also allow the Milton Police Department to enforce violations of this ordinance. This would be a similar approach that the City has taken in the past, to restrict parking along Rainbow Drive during school hours.

Fiscal Impact

There is no fiscal impact to Ordinance 483

Recommended Motion

The City Administration recommends approval of Ordinance 483 Restricting Parking at Veteran's Park to 2-hours during school hours.
