Summary

Milton Optimist Club is planning the 2021 Independence Day Run/Walk scheduled for July 4th. This year's event will include a 10K walk/run and 1 mile run. By Ordinance, Sec. 54-67, approval is required by the Public Works Committee and Common Council since the event is held on public right-of-way or public premises.

Analysis and Key Issues

The race will begin at the Milton High School at 8:00 AM. All participants must be off the course by 9:50 AM. The 10K route will begin on West High Street and end on Municipal Drive. The streets affected include portions of Manogue Road, Kennedy Road, Elm Street, Golden Lane, and South John Paul Road. The one-mile run begins on Rainbow Drive near Cottonwood Lane and finish on Municipal Drive. The route will include Basswood Lane and Hilltop Drive. Central park is used as the finish area.

Fiscal Impact

The event does require the use of City resources and labor for the time to provide and set-up barricades. Police Officers will assist with traffic at intersections within the route. This work will be performed by City crews and may incur overtime.
