### Event Description

We're excited to be back for an in-person event this year! Join us for a fun, family-oriented race to start off the 4th of July holiday. There's something for everyone - a competitive one-mile race on residential streets with a great downhill finish and a picturesque 10K out-and-back course with rolling hills.

While the courses haven't changed, some of our procedures have to keep everyone safe. Please read through our event requirements before registering:

- The race will be held, weather permitting.
- The race will NOT be timed. Please time yourself.
- Face masks are **REQUIRED** for everyone. Participants may remove masks while running.
- There will be a rolling start to reduce congestion.
- Please maintain social distance of 6 feet from other participants. Families/pods may run together.
- If you don't feel well on race day, please sit this one out.
- As always, you participate at your own risk.
- There are no refunds.

Thank you for helping to keep everyone healthy. Run proceeds support youth in the Milton community throughout the year through the club's Kids on Stage Theater program, community projects, sports team sponsorships, high school scholarships, library summer reading program and Breakfast with Santa.

### Event details and schedule

**Registration:** Online registration closes June 29; receive a discount for registering before June 29. After June 29 the prices increase as following:

- Age 10 and under with a T-shirt \$10
- Age 10 and under without a T-shirt \$5
- Age 11 and up with a T-shirt \$25
- Age 11 and up without a T-shirt \$15

7-8:15 am on-site registration July 4 at Milton High School

**Race Day Location:** Milton High School, 114 West High Street, Milton, WI

**Bib Pickup:** 7-8:15 am at registration. No early bib pickup.

**Parking:** Ample parking is available at Milton High School with additional parking available across the street at Schillberg Park.

**Race Start Times:**

- 10K walkers start at 8:00 am
- 10K runners start at 8:30 am
- One-mile age group competitive run at 8:35 am

**Water Stations:** There are three water stations on the 10K course. There are no water stations on the one-mile course.

**Awards:** No age group awards this year, but all who register before June 29 will receive a medal.

**Participants must be off the course by 9:50 a.m.**
