Summary

Baxter & Woodman has provided the attached work order to perform engineering services related to construction of the TEA Agreement rail installation.

Analysis and Key Issues

Services to be provided include construction administration and field observation of the utility, and street improvements for the TEA rail as well as assist with the completion of the Putman Parkway extension. TerraTec Engineering and WisDOT will be performing services directly related to the installation of the rail track and appurtenances.

Fiscal Impact

Baxter & Woodman has provided an estimated cost for services of \$78,000. The actual amount billed will be based on actual work time performed. All costs are required to be reimbursed by the developer as part of the TIF agreement.
