Summary

Baxter & Woodman has provided the attached work order to perform design services for the replacement of existing water main along Madison Avenue between Front Street and Merchant Row.

Analysis and Key Issues

The water main along Madison Avenue between Front Street and Merchant Row has experienced several breaks in recent years. The proposed work order is for engineering design for the replacement of the existing water main. Additional survey work will be included in the event the water main work or the street improvement limits are extended.

Fiscal Impact

Baxter & Woodman has provided a work order for services not to exceed \$13,900. The actual amount billed will be based on actual work time performed. The water main replacement and associated work will be funded through the water utility. Further discussion will be needed if extending the project limits to perform pavement replacement is desired.

Recommended Motion

Approve the work order from Baxter & Woodman for the Madison Avenue Water Main Replacement.
