Summary

The Department of Natural Resources has requested the City approve a new resolution authorizing the Public Works Director to act on the City’s behalf for administration of the recycling grant.

Analysis and Key Issues

Each year the City applies for a recycling grant that is available through the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. The application to request financial assistance requires an authorized person to act on the City’s behalf. The current authorized person is retired Public Works Director Howard Robinson.

The Department of Natural Resources recommends the Council authorize an employment position rather than an individual name to allow for staff changes. Staff recommends appointing the position of “Public Works Director” to this role.
