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### Summary

On June 17, 2014, the Milton Common Council adopted Ordinance #396 creating a mobile business license which governed the operation of mobile businesses (food trucks) in the City of Milton. The ordinance created Article XIII of Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances which outlines the terms and conditions in which mobile businesses may operate under in the City.

Currently the City permits mobile businesses to be present during "private events" with no oversight from the City. However, the businesses wish to operate outside of a "private event" Ordinance #396 governs the conditions in which that may exist.

However, since the time of adoption, the City has seen a greater proliferation of uses and requests for these types of businesses. Therefore, City Staff is inquiring as to if the Common Council may wish to revisit this Ordinance to allow for greater access of these types of business in the City or with greater restrictions.
