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### Summary

Baxter & Woodman has prepared a work order to complete design services for the construction of a new wastewater lift station to serve undeveloped properties on Milton's northeast side.

### Analysis and Key Issues

The project consists of providing design for the construction of a new wastewater lift station to serve an undeveloped area on Milton's northeast side. A conceptual plan and design was completed in October 2021 for this project and is the basis for the design. The station will discharge through a force main to the City's existing interceptor sewer.

### Fiscal Impact

The project costs could be assessed to the parcels served by the future lift station.

### Recommended Motion

Approve the work order for Engineering Services in the amount of \$37,500 for the Northeast Lift Station Design.
