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### Summary

Purchase of Radar Signs

### Analysis and Key Issues

The approved 2022 budget allocated funds for the purchase of up to six radar signs to be located along City streets. These signs will notify drivers of their speeds as they approach the signs and are solar powered. The signs are planned to be located along Parkview Drive, North Janesville Street and North Clear Lake Avenue.

### Fiscal Impact

TAPCO provided the lowest quote for the purchase of the signs and mounting hardware in the amount of \$2,680.00 per sign. Purchasing six signs will cost \$16,080.00 and is less than the amount included in the 2022 Budget.

### Recommended Motion

City administration recommends approving the purchase of six radar signs from TAPCO.
