Call to Order

Chairperson Ald. Bill Wilson called the March 8, 2022 meeting of the Public Works Committee to order at 5:02 p.m.

Approval of Agenda

S. Thomas motioned to approve the March 8, 2022 agenda. M. Doolittle seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Approval of Minutes – November 8, 2021

M. Doolittle motioned to approve the November 8, 2021 minutes. M. Striegl seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Municipal Agreement to Purchase Sodium Chloride on WisDOT Bid

Director Langer reviewed the WisDOT bid and the municipal agreement that the City of Milton utilizes to purchase Sodium Chloride for the roads.

Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Storm Water Utility User Fees and Modification of the Assessment Requirements for Curb and Gutter

M. Striegl motioned to recommend approval of Resolution #2022-08 Establishing Equivalent Runoff Unit (ERU) charge to the Common Council. S. Thomas seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

S. Thomas motioned to recommend approval of Ordinance #2022-491 amending section 66-241(a) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Milton concerning assessments for public works improvements to the Common Council. M. Striegl seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.

Presentation of Annual Municipal Separate Storm Sewers (MS4) Permit

Director Langer presented the annual MS4 report to the committee.

Discussion and Possible Direction on Application for Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) Funding

M. Doolittle motioned to recommend to Council to apply for Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding for High Street between John Paul Road and Janesville Street, West Madison Avenue between the City Limits and Clear Lake Avenue and Hilltop Drive between High Street and

Madison Avenue for funding years and funding amounts to be determined by staff. S. Thomas seconded, and the motion carried unanimously.


General Items
