Summary

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) has made available funding for Wisconsin Municipalities to replace lead service lines (LSLs) on private property. The City of Milton has applied for funding through this program and been awarded \$300,000 in principal forgiveness funding.

Analysis and Key Issues

Water service lines consist of two components. The public service line (Utility owned) between the water main in the street and the curb shut off. The other component is the private service line between the curb shut off and the building. This program provides funding for eligible City of Milton Water Utility Customers to replace their service lines.

Fiscal Impact

Program funding is principle forgiveness for the private LSL. Utility owned LSL replacements will be required to be funded with Utility funds.

Recommended Motion

Approve the Resolution Authorizing Execution of the Department of Natural Resources Principal Forgiven Financial Assistance Agreement.
